INFRASTRUCTURE CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES FACING S.A.'s MINING SECTOR

Challenges and opportunities facing the mining sector in South Australia are being put under the microscope today at a special infrastructure luncheon organised by the South Australian Chamber of Mines and Energy (SACOME) at the Sebel Playford Hotel.

The issues have been identified in a special study for SACOME undertaken by a consortium comprising Connell Wagner, Supply Chain Logistics Advisory (SCM) and AustralAsia Economics.

Specific areas examined include the supply of water, power, gas, transport and communications to developing mine sites, highlighting areas for collaboration between Government and industry.
